NOTIFICATION: CHANGED TRAFFIC CONDITIONS CADEL EVANS SURF COAST CLASSIC ROAD RACES LORNE TO TORQUAY- WEDNESDAY 29 AND THURSDAY 30 JANUARY 2025

The Surf Coast Classic Women's and Men's Races will start in Lorne and finish in Torquay on Wednesday 29 January and Thursday 30 January respectively. Both races are part of the Cadel Evans Great Ocean Road Race weekend of world class cycling. On each day, A field of 100 plus pro-cyclists will start on Mountjoy Pde between William St and Bay St at 11.00am and race to Torquay via inland roads with the support of Victoria Police.

Disruption to traffic will be minimal and Great Ocean Road will remain open after a brief 15 min hold between Mountjoy Pde (at William St and Bay St) and Deans Marsh-Lorne Rd roundabout for the race start. See table below for summary.

Short detour in place via Smith St for all Great Ocean Road traffic Lorne Beach Carpark closed Tuesday 28 January 7.00pm to Thursday 30 January 5.00pm
Deans Marsh	15-20 min rolling road closures managed by Victoria Police between 11.15am and 11.45am
Hinterland	15-20 min rolling road closures managed by Victoria Police between 11.30am and 2.00pm
Bells Beach	15-20 min rolling road closures managed by Victoria Police between 1.30pm and 2.30pm
Torquay	15-20 min rolling road closure into Torquay managed by Victoria Police between 1.45pm and 2.45pm

The Race route will take in the towns of Deans Marsh, Barwon Downs, Forrest, Yeodene, Whoorel, Bambra, Modewarre, Bells Beach and Jan Juc.

PARKING RESTRICTIONS -Lorne and Hinterland

There will be restricted parking on any road which the course travels along. To assist, please ensure you park your car either on a driveway or on a side street off the course.

Please note that emergency access will be maintained at all times.
